Matrix: MODERATELY SOFT DARK BROWN SANDY SILT WITH VERY LITTLE POTTERY AND BONE, IN COMPARISON WITH L9937 ABOVE IT. F9937 IS A FRAGMENTARY KURKAR FLOOR WHICH HAS A MINIMUM OF 3 RESURFACINGS.

Relations: L9994 IS COVERED BUT NOT SEALED BY L9937. IT COVERS AND MAY SEAL THE UNEEXCAVATED MATERIAL BELOW. THIS IS BECAUSE A SMALL PATCH OF FLOOR BELOW L9994 WAS DISCOVERED, INTO WHICH AN AMPHORA HAD BEEN PLACED. THIS FLOOR MAY EXTEND ACROSS THE ENTIRE ROOM, BUT THERE IS NO TIME LEFT IN THIS SEASON TO TRACE IT. L9994 REACHES THE MUDBRICK/STONE PHASE OF W9729, AS WELL AS THE LARGER STONE PHASES OR THE SECOND FROM THE TOP, OF W9211, W9266, AND W9684.

L9994 APPEARS TO CONTINUE INTO L9949 - THE MATRIX OF L9994 AND L9949 AT THIS ELEVATION, ARE VIRTUALLY IDENTICAL.
