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**Summary**

**Opened:** When a pit-like deposit was noticed in the W section of L9908

**Limits (N)** L9908 and L9997?

**(S)** L9900

**(E)** L9908

**(W)** Balk with A132

**Closed:** End. of Season - Not Closed

**Matrix:** Light grey material without many inclusions. Distinct from the yellow brown material of L9908 and the sherd-riddled pit L9900 similar to L9997

**Relations:** [L9996] is covered and sealed by L9869, the floor makeup of F9851/F9993. It continues down in the S<sup>93</sup> unnumbered and unexcavated fill below.\* Because it was not distinguished early on as a separate deposit from L9908 all of its material from this season is lumped in with L9908.

To the N: [L9996] may continue as part of a sprawling fill in L9997. It would have covered or reached 9908 save for the mixing

To the E: [L9996] would cover or reach L9908.

To the S: L9990 (pit) cuts a beautiful vertical line with L9996. No chance of mixing there

To the W: [L9996] continues into the balk.

Though pit-like in form [L9996] (with L9997) may actually be a leveling fill used to prepare the area to receive F9851/F9993. Only further excavation in A132 and A132 can resolve the fill/pit question.

\* L9996 covers, but does not seal W9998 below

**Additional Observations/Value:** Mixed material. Deposit not recognized early enough. All its material lumped in with 9908
